

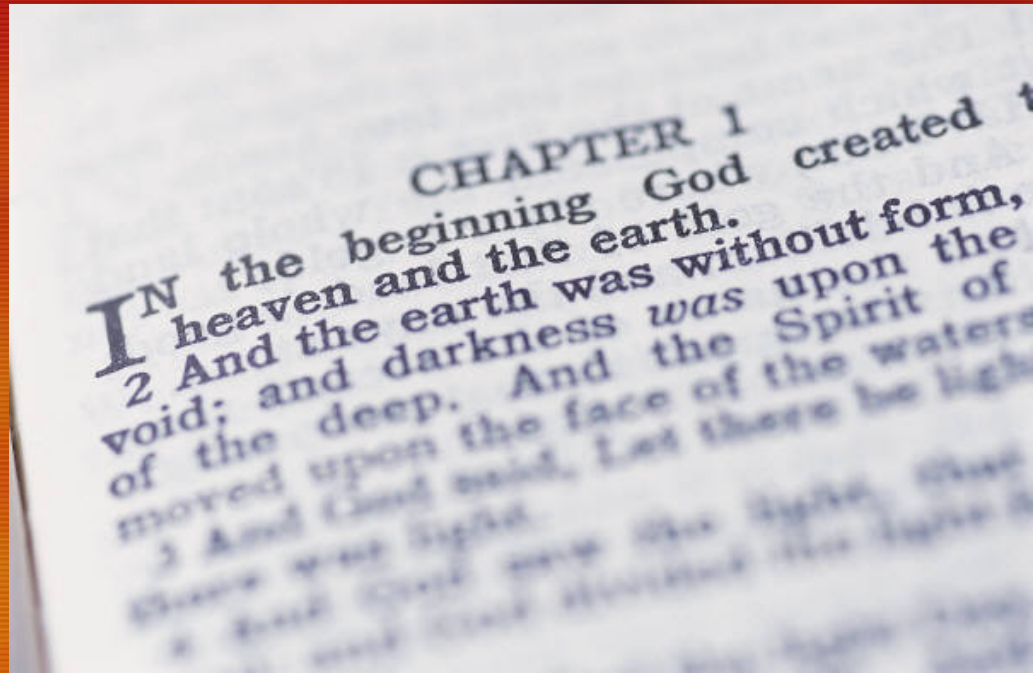

II Samuel 18:22



Rewards of Preparation


- Enables teacher to concentrate on students

Suggested Weekly Schedule





Saturday	Highlight Lesson/Pray

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
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
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
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
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
