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An Architect at Work



- Lesson follows a design originating in the mind of the teacher
- The teacher keeps the purpose of lesson always in mind
- Design is placed on paper

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An Architect at Work



Language must be common to teacher and student
Design submitted to higher 'planning commission'

- Rewrite plan
