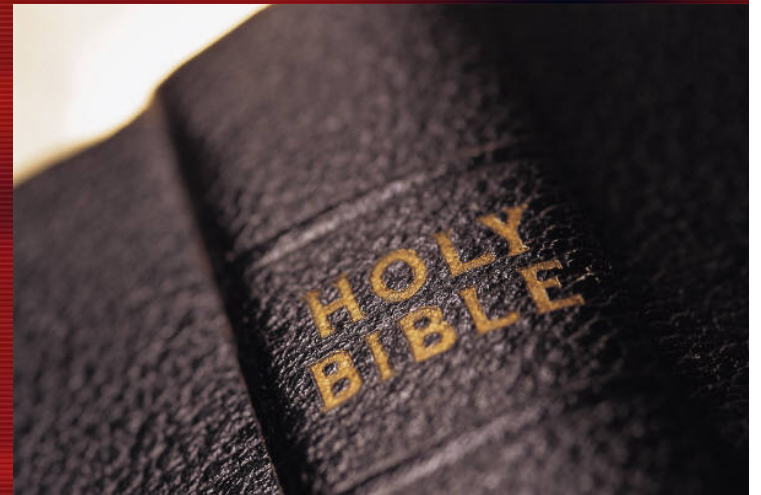
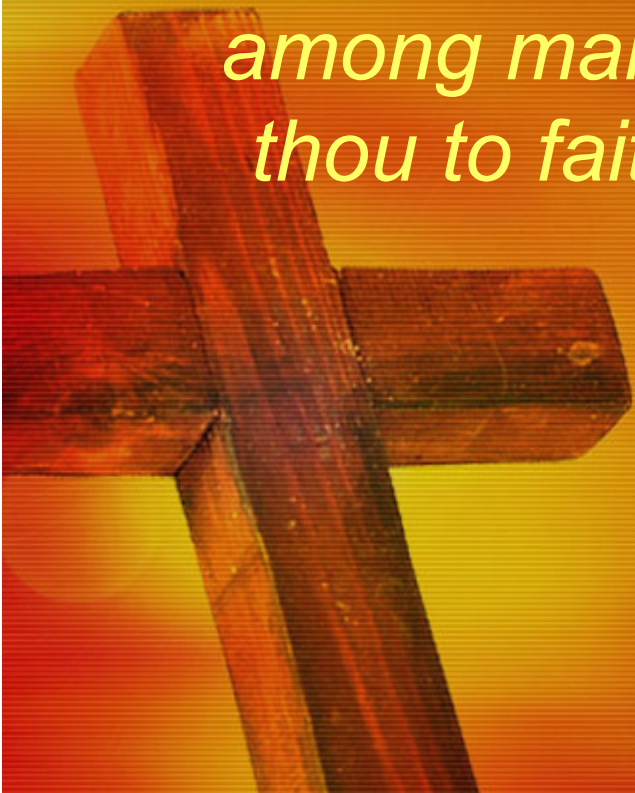

The Teacher

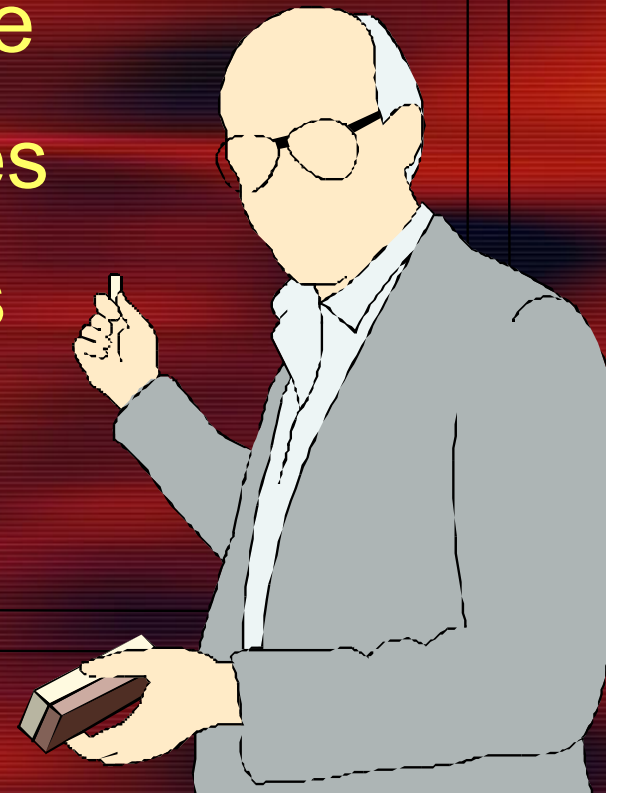
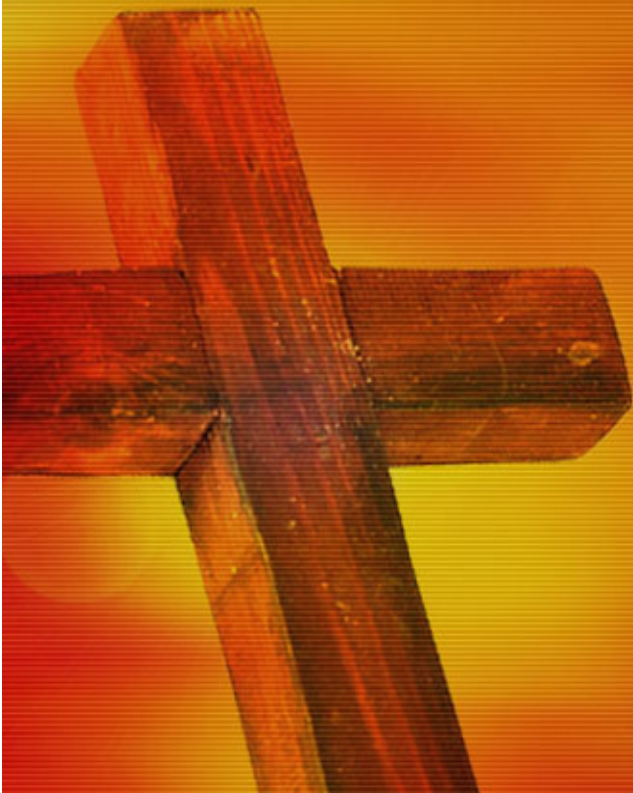
- Does not own

The authority to teach comes from God

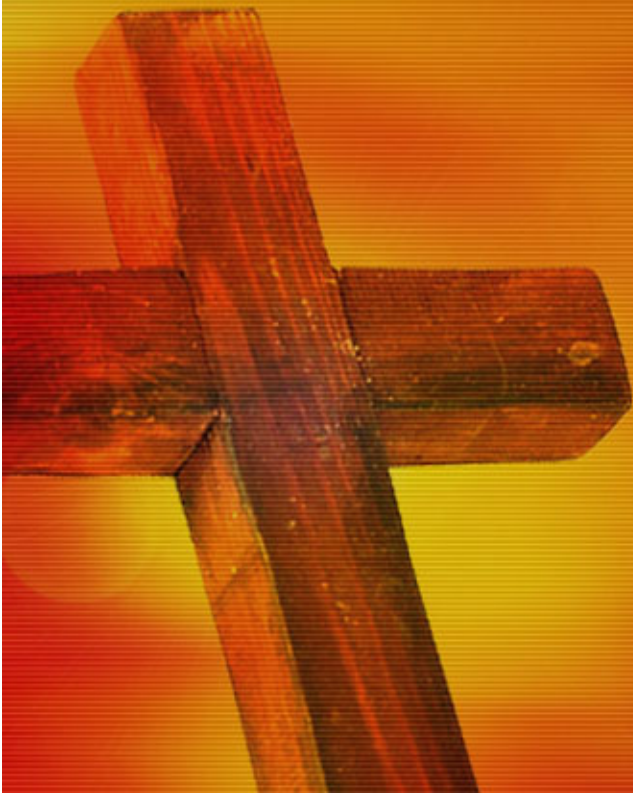
A Teacher Must Know His Attitude

A Teacher Must Keep The Big Picture in Mind

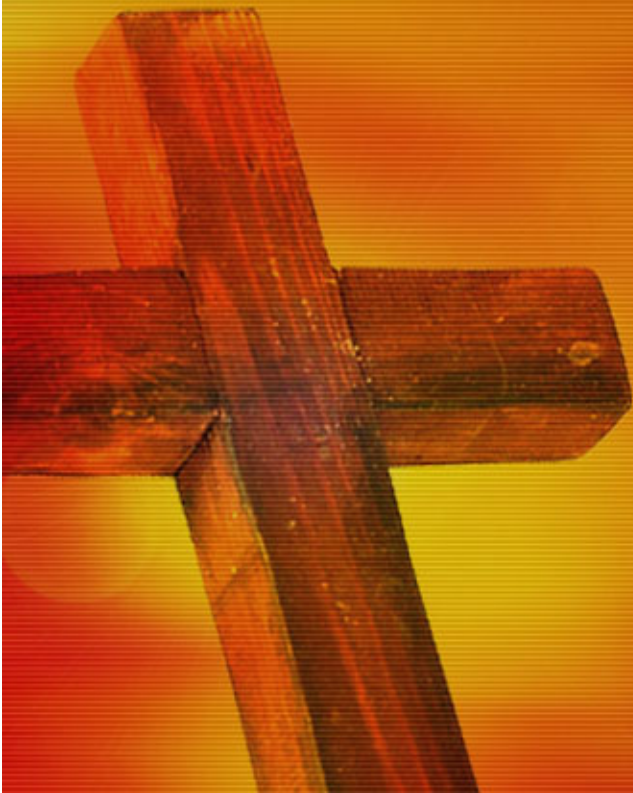
- Keep the main thing the main thing
